	Application form & declarations duly signed
	Copy of your passport's data page (A4 size copy)
	Personal covering letter explaining the exact purpose of your stay in Germany
	Work Contract confirming conditions of your stay in Germany, including salary and social insurance payments
	ZAV Application form (will be filled out by the International Institute of Culinary Arts, New Delhi)
	Qualification Certificate (from International Institute of Culinary Arts, New Delhi)
	Curriculum Vitae (in tabular form)
	Proof of 6 years' work experience as a cook specialized in Indian food
	Birth certificate
	School leaving certificate
	3 passport pictures according to biometric specifications, not older than 6 months
	Demand Draft

Please prepare two identical application sets with the above-mentioned documents and bring your original certificates along. Please DO NOT staple any documents.
